Boat Accident at Tyree—On Monday, 26th ultimo, Colin Brown, merchant. his little boy, about seven years of age, and his brother-in-law, Donald M'Lean, left Tyree in a small boat with the intention going the Island of Coll. Everything went well till they were within a short distance from their destination, when suddenly the boat was upset by a squall, and its unfortunate occupants precipitated into the water. M'Lean managed to keep hold of the boat till assistance was rendered him from the shore, but Brown and his son were drowned.
