OBITUARY

General regret was expressed in Lyttleton at the somewhat sudden death of Mr **Alexander Rose Campbell**, who passed away in Christchurch Hospital on Saturday morning, after a very brief illness. Mr Campbell who was only in his 39th year, was born on the Island of Tyree, on the north coast of Scotland, and went to sea at an early age. He visited most parts of the world, and for 10 years was in the service of the Union Steam Ship Company. During the past five years he acted as caretaker of the Westport Coal Company's hulk *Chittoor* at Lyttleton. Mr Campbell was very popular and much respected in Lyttleton, was a prominent Orangeman, and was one of the founders and secretary of the United Services Lodge.
