IN MEMORIAM: **HUGHES**

In loving remembrance of **Jessie**, the beloved wife of William Hughes, second daughter of the late Archibald and Mary Campbell, born in the island of Tiree, Argyleshire, Scotland, March 14th 1836. Died at her residence, Glebe-street, Parramatta, July 28th, 1886, aged 50 years.

Additional notes:

Sister of Jane Campbell (13) and Niel Campbell (19).

In the Tiree Old Parish Register Janet (Jessie), daughter of Archibald Campbell & Mary Campbell of Scarinish, Tiree, is shown as being born on 8 March 1834, not 14 March 1836 as stated in the above newspaper report of her death. The parish register lists 5 children born in Tiree to Archibald & Mary Campbell:

Jane, 1828
Duncan, 1830
Niel, 1832
Janet, 1834
Mary, 1837

The Campbell family emigrated to Australia on the bounty ship *British King*, which sailed from Tobermory, Mull, on 28 October 1838 and arrived in Sydney on 28 February 1839.

Jessie Campbell married William Hughes at Parramatta, New South Wales, in 1856. The births of 11 children were registered, all at Parramatta:
