Jane, eldest child of Archibald Campbell & Mary Campbell of Scarinish, Tiree, was born on 22 June 1828. The parish register lists 5 children born in Tiree to Archibald & Mary Campbell:

Jane, 1828
Duncan, 1830
Niel, 1832
Janet, 1834
Mary, 1837

The Campbell family emigrated to Australia on the bounty ship *British King*, which sailed from Tobermory, Mull, on 28 October 1838 and arrived in Sydney on 28 February 1839.
