

## The Bounty Ships Scheme to Australia

### *George Fyfe*

The *George Fyfe* was the 16<sup>th</sup> of 20 Bounty Scheme ships. She sailed from Tobermory, Mull, on the 15<sup>th</sup> September 1839 and arrived in Sydney on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 1840, carrying 178 passengers, mainly from Argyll, Skye or Inverness.
